FRENCH MINISTRY

Over the years, Liane and I have had the privilege of crossing paths with so many of you who are vital partners to our mission. Our prayer is that the work of the Atlantic District in the East will converge with the work of the Quebec District in an awesome explosion of revival. (The same is true for our partner to the west, Ontario, but we'll save that for another newsletter.)
