FAMILY

Josh is in communication studies at Concordia University, Jared is in computer science at Champlain College, and Jonathan is in his second-last year at Centennial High School. Time flies!

BUDGET

Challenges of the US dollar and the price of gas aside, we are so humbled by the faithfulness of our partners in missions. We appreciate you! Special thanks to Louisiana Home Missions who are helping us to buy a church van; and the Hernandez family in Texas for sending 3 cases of Bibles during AYC.

LANGUAGE STUDY

Scott is now able to preach in French, and Liane is almost finished her translation program at Concordia University. She is working to help produce and coordinate apostolic French resources for discipleship and training.

MISSIONS TRIPS

In 2010, we hosted 10 students and staff from Purpose Institute, who helped us launch a church in the South Shore. This summer, AYC sent 29 students to do street evangelism and hold special services. In 2012, we will be hosting a missions group from the West Virginia district headed by Robert Fazzalore.

SOUTH SHORE

Our church in Montréal's South Shore, a cluster of communities with over a million people, is steadily growing. We now have two services a week. We recently had 32 people at an outreach event, and had 60 at our Easter event.

TROIS-RIVIÈRES

We continue to oversee the church in Trois-Rivières, since they have been without a permanent pastor for over two years. This city is very multicultural, and the church has many Congolese and Burundian families, including two new ones recently.

SHERBROOKE & QUÉBEC CITY

We make periodic trips with Bible School students into these two cities where we have several contacts, including groups of Nepalese believers. Pray with us for someone who can go on site to build churches in these needy areas.

TRAINING

With less than 10 churches for a province of 8 million people, Québec's greatest need is trained labourers. We have been privileged to be involved in the local Bible school, which was phased into French and English Purpose Institute campuses last year. This year, we have about 30 students enrolled. Also, this summer, Purpose Institute sponsored a 3-day French Workers training seminar in Trois-Rivières, with over 80 in attendance. God is building his army!
